New incinerator plant for Baghdad International Airport

Incinco has just installed new incinerators at Baghdad International Airport (BIAP).

Commissioned by Toifor for the American Army this plant consists of two FS1250 incinerator units capable of together destroying 2.5 tonnes per hour of general airport waste.

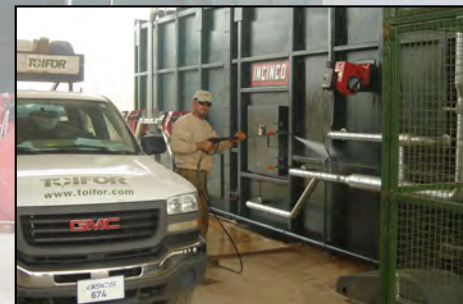
The incinerators are fully automatic controlled by PLC and consist of bin tippler, hydraulic auto feeder, primary and secondary chambers, reciprocating/riddling grates and ash conveyor.

BIAP is not only the main gateway into Iraq but is also used as a major base for the US military. Hungarian company Toifor have the contract for

the complete waste management of the site including waste collection and disposal. They commissioned Incinco late summer 2007 with the units being delivered early 2008.

Incinco's team of specialist installation and commissioning engineers travelled to site early April 2008 and have completed the project also providing full local on site training for operation and maintenance. The units are now fully operational and are destroying the mountain of waste collected from this vast site.
